Bill Venable Dies; Services On Friday

W. W. (Bill) Venable died at his home in Richmond, Virginia, Wednesday night, it was learned here today.

Funeral services will be held at the Bennett Funeral Home at Richmond Friday afternoon. Burial will be at the family plot in a cemetery at Virginia Beach, a short distance from Richmond.

Venable lived in Grinnell for 10 years, leaving here in the early 1960's. While here, he owned and operated the Cornland Plant Foods factory in partnership with Ray Sorenson.

After leaving Grinnell, he lived at Richmond and at Nassau in the Bahamas.

Survivors include his widow, Margaret; two sons, W. W. Jr. of New York City and Cabel of Richmond; and four grandchildren.

A memorial fund in Venable's name has been established at St. Paul's Episcopal church here. Venable was an active member of the church during his years in Grinnell.
