**dies in crash**

Anthony Vitera, 27, of Manson, a former Grinnell resident, was killed Wednesday in a one-car accident in Wright County.

The fatal crash occurred when Vitera lost control of his car on a curve near Lake Cornelia and rolled several times. Vitera was thrown from the vehicle.

Authorities said the accident occurred sometime between 4:30 and 6:30 p.m. Wreckage was discovered by a construction worker.

Funeral services for Anthony Vitera, 27, of Manson, formerly of the Grinnell area, were conducted at 10:30 a.m. today at the Grace United Methodist Church in Manson.

Burial will be at 3:15 p.m. today at Hazelwood Cemetery in Grinnell, with military graveside rites conducted.

Mr. Vitera was killed in a one-car accident northeast of Clarion early Wednesday morning. He was employed by Aspholm Excavating and Tiling of Manson at the time of his death.

Survivors include his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Rex Vitera of Manson; three brothers, Timothy of Manson, Lance Corporal James Vitera of Camp Pendleton, Calif., and Andrew of Manson; and four sisters, Dixie Sauter of Manson, Vera Grasso of Poestenkill, N.Y., Lorita Skelton of Manson and Molly Vitera, also of Manson.
