

Elsie Vogt dies at 81 ^{H-R}

Mrs. Elsie Vogt, 81, of St. Francis Manor in Grinnell, died early Friday, Dec. 31 at St. Francis Manor.

Funeral services for Elsie Vogt will be held at 10 a.m. on Monday, Jan. 3 at the Smith Funeral Home. The Rev. John F. Maze, minister of the Malcom-Sheridan Parish, will officiate. Organist will be Norman Goodbrod. Burial will be in Hazelwood Cemetery following cremation.

Elsie Vogt was born on Dec. 7, 1895 in Holdrege, Neb. She attended schools in Oskaloosa and graduated from New Sharon High School. Later, she attended Grinnell College, majoring in music.
