

Elizabeth Vos rites Wednesday

Elizabeth Vos, 80, of Lynnville died Sunday afternoon, March 6, at Grinnell General Hospital.

Funeral services were conducted at 1:30 p.m. Wednesday at the Friends Church in Lynnville, with the Rev., Kenneth Santee officiating.
