**Vos rites 1980**

## held today

Kendall Wade Vos, 20, of Lynnville, was killed in an accident on U.S. Highway 17 a mile south of Audobon Friday, when his straight truck ran off the road. *Jan. 25*

Funeral services for Kendall Vos will be held Monday at 2 p.m. at the Lynnville Friends Church, with the Rev. Kenneth Santee officiating. Burial will be at Woodland Cemetery in Lynnville.

Arrangements were handled by the Hardin Funeral Home in New Sharon.

Born April 1, 1959, he was the son of Clarence and Willa Mae DeKock Vos. He graduated from Lynnville-Sully High with the class of 1977.

He is survived by his mother and a brother, Curtis. He was preceded in death by his father, who died in 1977.

A spokesman for the highway patrol said Vos was northbound on Highway 17 when he failed to negotiate a curve. His truck went off the east side of the road, struck a drainage ditch, flipped and caught fire.
