Edward E. Watkins, 69, of Rte 1, Malcom, died Sunday, Sept. 13, at University Hospitals in Iowa City.

A memorial service was conducted at 1 p.m. Wednesday at the Sheridan United Methodist Church, with the Rev. William Schlobohm officiating. Burial was in the Sheridan Cemetery.

He was born on June 13, 1918, in Wellington, Kan., the son of Edward and Mary Hull Watkins. He was married to Wilma Cordes on March 13, 1953, at Wichita, Kan.
