Susun Moore Watson was born March 3, 1843, at Portstewart, County Antrim, Ireland, and departed this life March 13, 1912; aged 69 years and 10 days.

She was the youngest of a family of twelve. Only one brother survives her.

In 1859 she was united in marriage to Chas. Mueller and came to America the following year, before the end of which she was left a widow. She then entered into the service of a family with whom she traveled in foreign countries for twelve years. In 1873 she was united in marriage to Alexander Watson. To this union was born one daughter, Nellie, who survives her.

Mrs. Watson was a member of the Church of England in her early life, uniting with the Lutheran church in New York and after coming to Iowa she united with the United Presbyterian church of Ewart.

Her illness was of short duration and she passed away not knowing that her husband had preceded her by only eleven hours less than one week. Mrs. Watson was a devoted wife and mother and a kind and sympathetic neighbor and friend. There is something sad, yet beautiful in the departure of this husband and wife at so nearly the same time; sad because it comes as a double sorrow to the bereaved family, beautiful because while they were united in life they were not divided in death except by a few hours.

Funeral services were held at the United Presbyterian church of Ewart, Iowa, on Saturday, March 16, 1912, at 2 o'clock. These services were conducted by Rev. S. M. Hood, assisted by Rev. W. W. Woodburn. The remains were laid to rest in the Clover Hill cemetery at Ewart.
