

**Mrs. Julius
Weber Buried
1-5-1932 In Malcom**

Funeral services for Mrs. Julius Weber, a former resident of this county, who passed away at her home at El Reno, Okla., Jan. 2, were held at Malcom Monday, Jan. 4. The Rev. P. D. Aldershof, pastor of the Malcom Methodist church, conducted the services.

Mrs. Weber came to the United States from Germany when 16 years old, and lived in Montezuma for four years. She was born Nov. 26, 1847. In April, 1874, she married Julius Weber in Montezuma. They lived then in Grinnell for a few years, after which they moved to Malcom where they lived until March, 1901, when they went west.

The deceased is survived by seven children, all living in Oklahoma, Montana and Oregon. Seven grandchildren and two great grandchildren also survive. Interment was made in the Malcom cemetery.
