

## Grace K. Wee services held

Grace K. Wee, 83, of 105 Eighth Ave., Grinnell, died Wednesday, Dec. 18, at her home.

Funeral services were conducted at 1 p.m. Saturday at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Raymond Lott of the Grinnell United Methodist Church officiating. Organist was Kathleen Helfner, and pallbearers were Delmar Adkins, Ellis Brown, Robert Renaud, Kenneth Saunders, Clarence Scobee and Noel Taylor. Burial was in Resthaven Cemetery, West Des Moines.

The daughter of William J. and Sara Jane Shields Burrell, she was born July 17, 1902, at Bloomfield, Pa. The family moved to Estherville where she attended school. She received her teacher's certification from Iowa State Teachers College at Cedar Falls and taught in Emmet and Dickinson county schools.

On June 24, 1925, she was married to Arthur Z. Wee in Estherville. From 1930 to 1939

the couple lived in various Iowa communities before moving to Des Moines in 1939. While living in Des Moines, Mrs. Wee was employed at Younker's Department Store. In 1950 the couple moved to Grinnell where they owned and operated the McKey and Wee Firestone Home and Auto Supply Store. They retired in 1970 and continued to live in Grinnell.

Mrs. Wee was a member of the United Methodist Church, the Methodist Women's Societies and Circles of Grinnell, the Grinnell Women's Club and, for over 50 years, the Order of Eastern Star.

She is survived by her son, Duane A. Wee of Waterloo; four grandchildren; two great-grandchildren; and one sister, Hazel Erlandsen of St. Paul, Minn. She was preceded in death by her husband on Nov. 13, 1985; one daughter, Roberta Rae Wee in 1949; her parents; and two brothers, Maurice and Paul Burrell.
