For Mrs. Wells, 80;
Died on Tuesday

Mrs. Amy Wells, 80, passed away Tuesday at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Alma Adkins, and funeral services were held at 3:00 o'clock this afternoon at the Methodist church. Rev. C. D. Loose in charge. Interment was at Hazelwood cemetery.

Amy T. Latcham, daughter of William and Abigail Latcham, was born in Clayton, N. J., April 6, 1860. When she was about 11 years old her family moved near Montezuma, where she grew to young womanhood.

On her birthday, April 6, 1882, she was united in marriage to Marion C. Wells, who preceded her in death about 12 years ago. To this union five children were born: Mrs. Abbie E. Nutting, Mrs. Alma Adkins, Mrs. Greta D. Buckridge, all of Grinnell; William W. Wells of Pasadena, Calif.; and another daughter, Eva Fay, who died in infancy.

There are also two brothers, Ben Latcham of Montezuma and Leonard Latcham of Grinnell. Two brothers and two sisters preceded her in death. She is survived by 10 grandchildren.
