Martin Whiteman was born in Ohio in 1841, came to De Kalb, Ill., in 1842, where he grew to manhood and lived in the vicinity of De Kalb until the year 1873, when he moved to Dowagial, Mich., where he lived until 1876 when he came to Grinnell where he has lived until the time of his death, which occurred very suddenly May 20, 1901. He was married to Hannah C. Sebring, Aug. 7, 1883, who preceded him to the better world some four years ago. On May 2d, was united in marriage to Mary Malcolm, who is left to mourn the loss of a devoted husband. Mr. Whiteman was a good citizen, a respected neighbor and a loyal friend.
