

Old Resident Of ⁶⁻¹¹ Deep River Dies ³⁻²⁶⁻¹⁹²⁹

Evan Thomas Whitney, son of Myron and Sophia Whitney, was born January 11, 1863 at Dresden and departed this life at his home in Deep River after about two weeks of severe illness with pneumonia and complications, on March 13, 1929 at 6:45 a. m. He was 66 years, 2 months and two days old.

Mr. Whitney has lived in that vicinity all his life. He has been connected with the business life of Deep River township for fifty years and in business in Deep River for a good many years. He was converted about thirty-two years ago and joined the Methodist church of which he has been a member since. Mr. Whitney was also a member of the Masonic lodge.
