

^{MS} Lena Wilde Funeral Conducted Tuesday

Funeral services for Lena Wilde, 78, were conducted Tuesday afternoon at two o'clock at Bramer Funeral Home with the Rev. George W. Roquet, pastor of First United Presbyterian Church, officiating. Mrs. Ed Bartachek was organist.

Interment was in I.O.O.F. cemetery with the following serving as pallbearers: Raymond Williams, Richard Williams, Robert Williams, Hobart Powell, Evan Johnston and Edwin Montgomery. Flower attendants were Mr. and Mrs. Nelson Korn.

Miss Wilde's death occurred suddenly Sunday in Friendship Manor Home at Grinnell where she had made her home for the past several weeks. She had been in comparatively good health and had eaten her lunch shortly before her death.

The daughter of John and Eliza Wilde, she was born Nov. 27, 1887, at Montgomeryshire, England, and died July 3, 1966, at Grinnell. Since 1920 she had lived in Brooklyn and vicinity. She was a member of the Episcopal Church of England and the Rebekah Lodge of Brooklyn.

She is survived by a sister, Mrs. Maria Williams, who lives in the Presbyterian Home at Ackley. Preceding her in death were a sister, Gladys, and a brother, Edward.
