

## Mr. Wiley rites today

Dellmar B. Wiley, 83, of 1008 McClellan St., Tama, died Friday afternoon at his home of an apparent heart attack. *May 15*

Graveside services for Mr. Wiley will be conducted at 1:30 p.m. today at Hazelwood Cemetery, with the Rev. John C. Epperson of the Grinnell Christian Church officiating. Pallbearers will be C. Al Ahrens, Gary Maring, Robert Maring, Harvey Martindale, Bill Wiley and Warren Wiley. Burial will be in the cemetery's Greenwood section.
