George Williams Funeral Services Held This Morn

Funeral services for George T. Williams, 75, Grinnell, were held this (Thursday) morning from the James-Schalinske Funeral Home with the Rev. Lelan Mann officiating.

Mr. Williams died Monday morning at a Marshalltown hospital as the result of an auto accident near LeGrand Sunday afternoon.

Organist at the services was Mrs. Kathleen Heffner. Interment was in Cedar Memorial Park cemetery at Cedar Rapids. Graveside services were conducted by the Masonic Crescent Lodge No. 25.

The son of John B. and Mary Holland Williams, he was born on Oct. 5, 1884, in Kansas. He was educated and grew to manhood at Emmetsburg, Iowa.

In 1908, he was united in marriage with Ina Stedman at Emmetsburg. The following year they moved to Cedar Rapids and for the past 20 years made their home in Grinnell. Mr. Williams was employed as a salesman for the Grinnell Shoe Co.

He was a member of the Masonic Lodge, Shrine, Scottish Rite and Elks.

Survivors include his widow Ina; one daughter, Mrs. Sharp (Dorothy) Lannom, and four grandsons, all of Grinnell; two brothers, Gilbert of Compton, Calif., and Arthur J. of Emmetsburg; and his sister, Mrs. Len Thompson of Estherville.

He was preceded in death by his parents and one daughter.
