Bea Williams rites conducted

Hannah Beatrice Williams, 93, a former resident of the Lynnville area, died Friday, Jan. 22, at the Bloomfield Care Center in Bloomfield.

A memorial service was conducted at 10 a.m. Tuesday at the Priester Chapel in Bloomfield, with final committal services held at Forest Lawn Park, Oskaloosa.

Following her graduation from Lynnville High School and William Penn College, she taught a one-room school house for 12 years. After receiving her master's degree at Iowa State University, she served for 32 years as a supervisor of student teachers at St. Cloud State University in Minnesota.

She was given emeritus status following her retirement.

She then moved to Hendersonville, N.C., where she was active in the First Presbyterian Church, the P.E.O., Delta Kappa Gamma, Pi Lambda Theta, Opportunity House, friends of the Library and the Margaret Pardee Auxiliary.
