**JAMES FRANCIS WILLIAMS**

James Francis Williams, son of Mr. and Mrs. Frank Williams, was born Septmeber 10, 1912 in Seymour, Iowa, and passed away January 4, 1965, at Glendora, Calif., of a heart attack.

Services were held January 7 at Oakdale Chapel and burial was in Oakdale cemetery in Glendora, Calif., with the Rev. Harold E. Johnson, the Rev. Edward Erney and the Rev. William Rice officiating.

The deceased was married to the former Wanda Connelly of Grinnell.

He spent his early boyhood in the Grinnell area and attended the Grinnell schools, and was a member of the Methodist church.

He had been in the newspaper business for 20 years, 17 of them with the Register and Tribune in Des Moines, Ia. Prior to his death he was employed by Herald-Press Publications of Azusa, Calif.

During World War II he saw service as a member of the United States Marine Corps.
