**Marion Williams,
Rites At Kellogg;

Funeral services were held Friday at the Kellogg Methodist church for Marion T. Williams, 86, lifelong resident of that community who died Tuesday afternoon at a Newton hospital.

The Rev. Floyd Newbrough of Kellogg officiated at the rites and Masonic services were conducted by the Kellogg lodge. Interment was in Our Silent City cemetery at Kellogg.
