

Mrs. Williams Services Held

Graveside services were held Monday, April 15, at Hazelwood Cemetery, with the Rev. John McCallum, pastor of the Grinnell United Methodist Church, officiating. The daughter of Frederick William and Alice Stoker Kepcke, she was born Mar. 30, 1883, in Grinnell. She received her education in the Grinnell public schools.

On Jan. 31, 1907, she was married to George W. Williams in Montezuma. The couple had always made their home in Grinnell. Mr. Williams died in 1954. Also preceding her in death were three sisters, two brothers and a granddaughter.

Mrs. Williams was a member of the Grinnell Methodist Church and a charter member of the W.S.C.S. In 1965, she received the 50-year recognition from the Order of Eastern Star, Beulah Chapter No. 47, and 50-year recognition from the Rebekah Lodge. She was also a member of the Methodist Women's Bible Class of Marshalltown.
