Funeral Sunday

At Barnes City

Gertie, daughter of Pleasant and Nancy Dalbey Walters, was born south of Barnes City, Apr. 14, 1879, and died at the Mahaska hospital, Oskaloosa, Apr. 21, at 82 years of age.

She attended rural school and Normal, and taught several terms in the rural school.

On May 21, 1899, she was united in marriage with Joseph Wilson, and to this union two daughters were born.

They made their home on a farm for a few years, then moved to Barnes City, where Mr. Wilson engaged in carpentering. Since the death of her husband in April, 1933, she has maintained her present home.

She was a life-long member of the Christian church and was Sunday school superintendent for 14 years. She was active in the Aid Society as long as her health permitted.

She is survived by a daughter, Leola, of Barnes City, and a brother, Howard Likens, Monroe, Ore., other relatives and many friends.

Funeral services were held at 2:30 Apr. 23, at the Barnes City Christian church with Rev. Don Job, officiating.
