Former Grinnellian, Mrs. Ralph Wiltamuth Succumbs In Arizona

Funeral services were held at Arlington Chapel, D.C., on Wednesday, Feb. 2nd, for Mrs. Ralph Wiltamuth, who died at her home in the Phoenix, Ariz., on Friday, Jan. 28th, following a heart attack.

Her husband, Col. Ralph Wiltamuth, was with her at the time of death.

Mrs. Wiltamuth, the former Pearl Harris, was the daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Mayo Harris of Grinnell. She and her husband formerly resided here and attended Grinnell College. She was a member of the class of 1912.

Survivors, in addition to her husband, include: two sons, Col. Harris Wiltamuth, stationed in Taiwan, and Richard Wiltamuth of Seattle, Wash.; two grandsons, Nicholas, in Europe, and Stevan, at the University of Hawaii; and one granddaughter, Susan, in Taiwan.

Also surviving are a brother, Harry M. Harris of Moline, Ill.; and a sister, Olga Harris McNeil of New York City.

Another sister, Betty Harris Ellis, died in 1961.

Col. and Mrs. Wiltamuth celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary on Oct. 25th, 1965.
