Graveside Rites On Tuesday For Geo. Wisecarver

Graveside services were held at Hazelwood cemetery here Tuesday for George Jacob Wisecarver, 86, of Des Moines, a former Grinnell resident. Officiating at the services was the Rev. Chester E. Custer, pastor of the Grinnell Methodist church.

Mr. Wisecarver died Apr. 15th at Des Moines.

The son of Jacob and Frances Roseman Wisecarver, he was born June 4th, 1879, in Maysville, Scott county, Iowa. When he was a small child his family moved to a farm east of Grinnell where he grew to manhood.

He was united in marriage with Elizabeth Sparks and to this union four children were born.

He made his home in Grinnell until moving to Newton 30 years ago to make his home with his son, Earl J. Wisecarver and family. He had lived in Des Moines with his son the past 11 years.

Surviving are his son, Earl; his daughter in law; one granddaughter, Mrs. Cassa Jean Kuhn of Newton; and one great granddaughter, Michelle Kuhn.

Preceding him in death were his parents; his wife; three sons; two sisters, Mrs. Nettie Coop and Mrs. Jessie Dunham; and two brothers, William and Edward Wisecarver.
