Malcom Resident Mabel L. Wolfe Dies Here Tuesday

Mrs. Mabel L. Wolfe, 72, lifelong resident of the Malcom community, died Tuesday afternoon at a local hospital.

Funeral services will be held Friday at 2 p.m. from the James-Schalinske Funeral Home with the Rev. C. E. Kingsley, pastor of the First Baptist church, officiating. Interment will be in Ivy Hill cemetery at Malcom.

She was born on Jan. 13th, 1889 near Malcom, the daughter of Benjamin and Hannah Tinker Erickson. During her early youth her parents moved to Malcom and she attended the Malcom schools and was a graduate of Malcom high school.

On Nov. 25th, 1916, she was united in marriage with Harley Wolfe at Montezuma. Following their marriage they operated a restaurant in Malcom for a few years and for a number of years were engaged in a produce business.

Mr. Wolfe preceded her in death on March 22nd, 1952.
