

Mrs. John Wood Passes Away

Mrs. John W. Wood, 64, native resident of Jasper county, died Monday at her home near Laurel. Mrs. Wood had been ill for several years, and had been critically ill two weeks.

Funeral services will be conducted Wednesday at 1:30 p. m. from the Barrett church by the Rev. M. C. Melcher of the Methodist church of Laurel. Burial will be made in the Rock Creek cemetery.

Georgie Ann Bullock, daughter of William and Eliza Bullock, was born Dec. 8, 1870, at Lynnvilleville, Ia., one of a family of 10 children.

She was united in marriage to John William Wood at Grinnell on April 27, 1893, and to this union four children were born, all of whom survive.

She had lived all of her married life in Jasper and Poweshiek counties, with the exception of 10 years spent on a farm near Bethany, Mo.

She was preceded in death by her father; one sister, Mrs. Sadie Von Draska, and three brothers and sisters who died in infancy.

Surviving relatives include her husband; four children, Harry and John, at home, Mrs. Daisy Couper of Grinnell, and Mrs. Viola Marcum of near Grinnell; her mother, Mrs. Eliza Bullock of Grinnell; nine grandchildren; two brothers, William H. Bullock of LeGrand, Ia., and Thomas, whose address is unknown, and three sisters, Mrs. Etta May Sparks of Grinnell and Mrs. H. L. Henderson and Mrs. Grace Kelso, both of Des Moines.
