Mrs. N. O. (Sadie) Worth

Sadie Mullins, daughter of Frank and Melvina Mullins, was born in Marion county, Iowa, Nov. 5, 1872, and lived all of her life in and around Monroe.

When a young lady she accepted Christ and united with the Brethren church, and after moving to Monroe she continued to be active in Christian faith and service in the Baptist church so long as health permitted.

She was united in marriage to N. O. Worth in Dallas, Iowa, Nov. 28, 1900 and to this union was born one daughter, Avo. Mr. and Mrs. Worth celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary nearly four years ago.

Already suffering from neuritis, nearly ten years ago she broke her hip and seven years ago she was moved to a rest home in Grinnell where she was a cheerful patient until her death last Sunday, Aug. 22, 1954, at the age of 81 years.
