Gail Young, 75, of 334 East St., Grinnell, died Tuesday morning at Grinnell General Hospital following an extended illness.

Services will be held at 1:30 p.m. today at St. John's Lutheran Church, with Frank Philipp, intern seminarian, officiating. Music will be provided by Charles Hoogland, organist, and Jack Mithelman, vocalist. Pallbearers will be Carl Ahrens, Leo Ahrens, Lyle Muckler, Shirley Puls, Willard Robison, and James Urfer. Honorary pallbearers will be Wesley Ahrens, Loren Edgington, Myron Heneke, Earl Lidtka, Paul Schalinske and Orville Pedersen.

The son of Wayne and Nellie Sullens Young, he was born Nov. 7, 1901, in Rock Creek Township, Jasper County. He attended rural schools near the family farm and was graduated from Grinnell High School.

married to Elsie Pultz in Des Moines. Mr. Young was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith and was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church. He worked with the Rock Island Railroad for 22 years and with Miracle Recreation Equipment Co. before retiring five years ago.

Survivors include his wife; two brothers, Delmar Young of Little Falls, Minn., and Bernard Young of Grinnell; and two sisters, Mrs. Wendell (Bernice) Parmley and Mrs. Florence Fenner, both of Ladysmith, Wis. He was preceded in death by his parents, his two sons, Duane, who died in infancy, and Marvel, who died in 1974; and a brother, Glen Young, who died in infancy.
