Former Grinnellian Dies In Marshalltown

Mrs. James (Margaret) Young, 87, of Marshalltown died Thursday evening at her home.

A former Kellogg, Newton and Grinnell resident, Mrs. Young was born on April 27, 1880 in Newton to James H. and Virginia Hixson Allen.

She was married to James Young on March 15, 1905 at Newton. Mr. Young died in 1959.

Mrs. Young was raised in Jasper County and lived for 40 years on a farm southwest of Kellogg after she was married. She lived in Grinnell for nine and one-half years before moving to Marshalltown in 1953.

Survivors include one daughter, Elma Young of Marshalltown; one son, Orrin Young of Waterloo; three grandchildren; one great-grandchild; and one brother, Geo. Allen of Newton.

Services were held at 10 a.m. today (Monday) at Purse-Davis Funeral Home at Marshalltown and at 2 p.m. today (Monday) at the Johnson Funeral Home in Newton.

Burial was in the Newton Union Cemetery.
