W. Zimmerman Dies In Lynnville

Willard Zimmerman, 70, a long-time Lynnville resident, was found dead in his home Wednesday. He lived in a house on the Marshall Meredith farm, one mile outside of Lynnville.

He was born January 20, 1897, the son of Will and Laura Zimmerman.

A World War I veteran, he lived for a short time in the soldiers' home in Marshalltown. He worked as a farm laborer most of his life.

Mr. Zimmerman was preceded in death by two brothers, Luther and Carl, and a sister, Zoe Swan.

He was never married.

Funeral services will be held Saturday at 2 p.m. at the Toland Funeral Home in Newton. The Rev. Peter Schuler will conduct the service.
