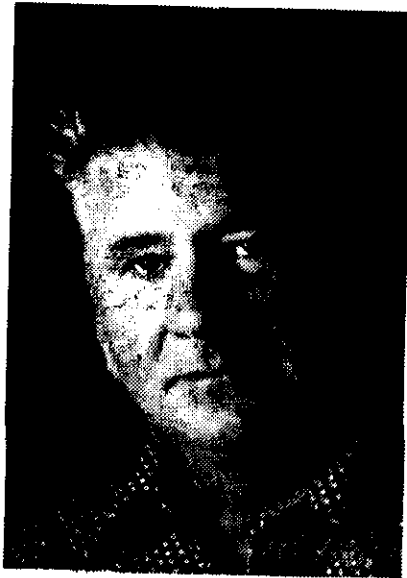


Hugh A. Pherigo



Hugh A. "Bud" Pherigo, 69, of Rock Creek Lake near Kellogg died of a heart attack Saturday, Sept. 22, at Mercy Hospital Medical Center in Des Moines.

The body was cremated, and no services were planned. There was a private family burial. McLaren Funeral Chapel of West Des Moines handled arrangements.

A native of Newton, he lived there until moving to Rock Creek Lake in 1968. Mr. Pherigo was a U.S. Army veteran of the Korean Conflict.

He was employed for 41 years at Newton Union Cemetery, retiring in 1995.
