O. Eugene Smith, 73, of Grand Junction, Colo., died on Friday, May 30, at his home.

Funeral services will be held Friday, June 6, at the Smith Funeral Home in Grinnell. Interment will be at Hazelwood Cemetery in Grinnell, with military honors.
