Dale L. White, 84, of Lynnville died on Saturday, Dec. 21, at the Grinnell Regional Medical Center of congestive heart failure.

Funeral services for Dale White will be held at 11 a.m. on Tuesday, Dec. 24, at the Lynnville Friends Church, with Pastor Pete Schuler and Cindy Norman officiating. Interment will follow at Friends Cemetery in Lynnville.

Visiting hours will be today (Monday) at the Harden Funeral Home in New Sharon; family will greet friends from 6 to 8 p.m. Monday evening.

Dale L. White was born on June 30,

1918, near Chelsea, the son of David and Nellie Lanning White. At an early age, he and his family moved to the Lynnville area; he graduated from Grinnell High School in 1936.

He married Reva Klyn at her parents home near Lynnville on Oct. 11, 1940.

White farmed in the Searsboro area till moving to Taintor in 1953. He retired from farming in 1980 and moved to Lynnville. He was an active member of the Lynnville Friends Church and served as president of the Taintor Co-op. He enjoyed annual trips to Canada with a Lynnville fishing group, as well as gardening and spending time with his grandchildren.

He is survived by his daughter, Sharon Sparks, of Bloomfield; his son, Duane White of New Sharon; six grandchildren; three brothers, Myron White of Grinnell, Norman White of Ankeny and Lyle White of Tama; and a sister, Vivian Graham of Grinnell.

He was preceded in death by his parents and his wife.
