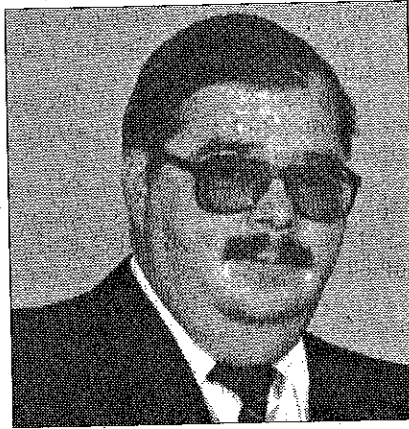


Jay William Butcher
