She will be remembered for many things, but particularly for her special orange drink recipe and chocolate no-bake cookies. Mowing the lawn, putting puzzles together, writing poems about her family, and traveling to craft shows with her daughters were some of Irene's favorite pastimes. Her four children and their families were very important to her which was evident in the poems she wrote for them. In November of 2005, Irene became a resident at Jefferson Place in Pella, Iowa. Irene resided there until becoming a Hospice patient at the Hospice of Pella Comfort House.
