Elmer Erickson Dies At Hospital

Elmer Erickson, 82, the father of Luther Erickson of 1415 Summer St., Grinnell, died Tuesday (March 23) morning at Grinnell General Hospital following a short illness.

The son of Hans and Dina Severson Erickson, Mr. Erickson was born June 18, 1888, in Pulaski, Wis. He attended the rural schools in Shawano County, Wis. and was graduated with the last class of St. Ansgar Seminary in 1910.
