

Mr. John Tice died at his home in Chester twp. Thursday. A short service was held at the house yesterday afternoon at 1:30, and then in the Congregational church at 3:00 o'clock; conducted by Rev. E. M. Vittum, assisted by Rev. J. J. Mitchell, Mr. Tice having been a member of that church. The music was furnished by Messrs. Walker and Herrick, Mrs. Christian and Miss Hibbard. The body was interred in Hazelwood. Deceased was born in Muscatine county thirty-two years ago, where he lived until he came to this vicinity a few years ago. Until the past winter he has lived at Newburg, where he was known as an honorable, upright man, industrious, of highest integrity, one always worthy of trust.
