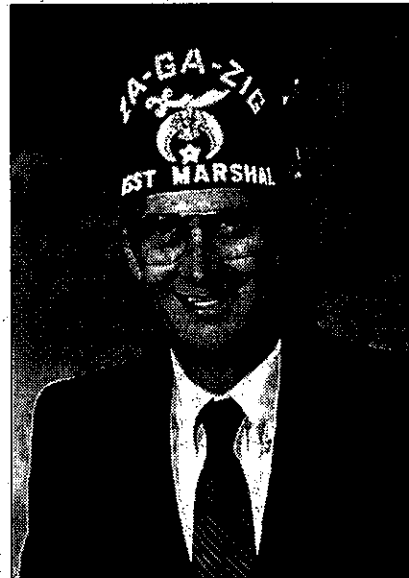


Robert J. Bullock, Jr.
