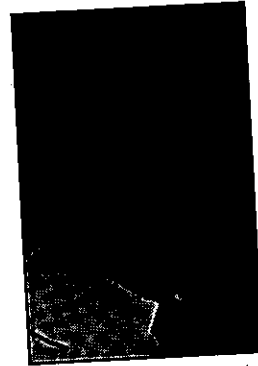
He honorably served in the United States Navy as a 2nd Class Pharmacist Mate 2c from 1943 until his discharge in 1946.
