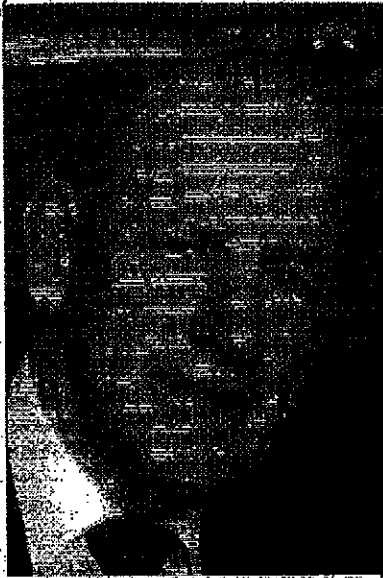


Forrest B. Young
