

PAULINE DRAPER REYNOLDS SODERHOLM

Pauline Draper Reynolds Soderholm, 85, of Ames, died April I at Israel Family Hospice House in Ames. Services were April 5, at Bethesda Lutheran Church in Ames. Burial was in Buckingham Cemetery near Traer.

Pauline Draper was born March 12, 1928, on a farm near Traer. She was the fifth child of Norman W. and Bertie (Huston) Draper. She was graduated from Traer High Record 4-11-2013

School in 1946 and attended Wm. Penn College.

Pauline married Paul D. Reynolds on October 10, 1948 in Traer. They had two sons, Paul David Reynolds and Payce Dean Reynolds.
