Betty J. Hotchkin, 68, of Grinnell, died on Wednesday, March 19, 2014, at Grinnell Regional Medical Center.

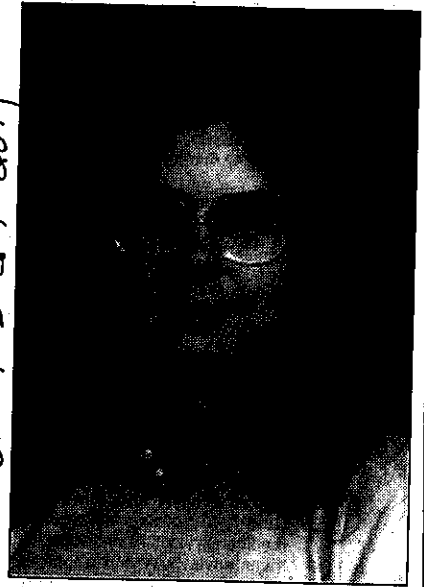
