friends.

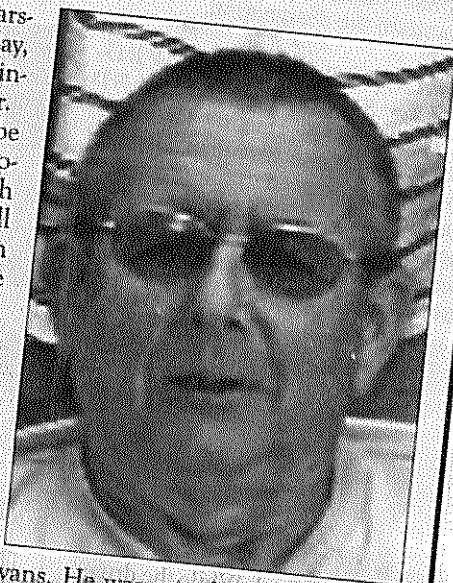
