The sad news reached Grinnell last week of the death at Wichita, Kansas, of Miss Adella Smoke, 84. She had lived in this city for a number of years and was known as an earnest christian charg acter, always a worker in church and so clety and a brilliant student. The Wich ita Regie devotes two columns to a review of her life and work, attesting in strong language her popularity and influence among the young people in that oity. She was born in 1861, taught school at thirteen, graduated at Iowa College in 1884, was principal at Polk City, Idwa, seelstant in the Grinnell High school teacher in an academy at King flabor, Ok., afterwards taught in Fair mount College Kas, and was principal of the Ellsworth High school when she was taken ii.
