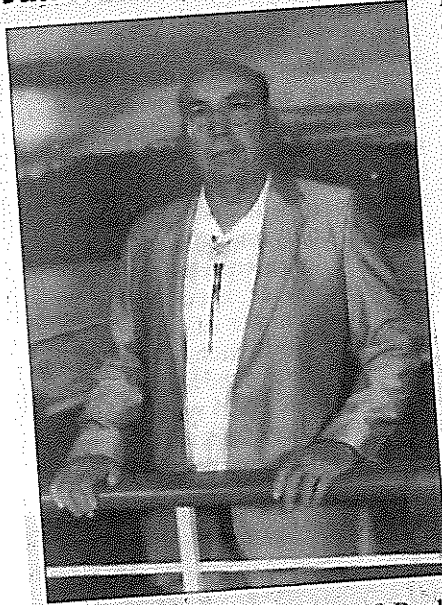


James Carl Luckey
