

Arthur DeBoef passes away at 100

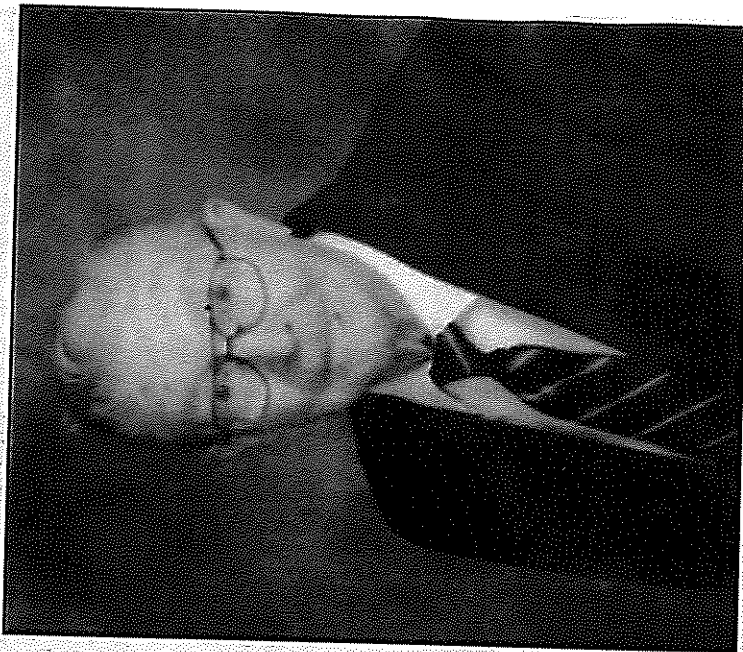
