

## Mrs. W.S. Hendrixson Dies In New York; Funeral Here Friday

Word has been received in Grinnell of the death on Sunday of Mrs. W. S. Hendrixson in New York, where she has been making her home with her daughter Phyllis, Mrs. George Barrett. Her son, Philip, of Wilmington, Delaware, is expected to arrive in Grinnell this evening with the body. Tentative plans call for funeral services to be held Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock in the Congregational church, in charge of Dr. J. S. Nollen and Rev. Leland W. Mann, with Professor Elias Blum at the organ. Interment will be in Hazelwood cemetery. Pall bearers will be Carl E. Child, G. Lester Duke, Grant O. Gale, L. P. Sherman, J. G. Shifflett and E. D. Strong.

Mrs. Barrett, who recently underwent a serious operation, was not able to come to Grinnell.

Mrs. Hendrixson was the

widow of Professor W. S. Hendrixson, for many years head of the college chemistry department, who first met his future wife after a runaway accident in Colorado, in which she had been injured. A woman of great charm and lovable personality, she is vividly remembered by all who knew her during her years of residence here. The former Hendrixson home, at the corner of Ninth avenue and Park street, now occupied by Mr. and Mrs. R. S. Kinsey, will be remembered as a center of gracious hospitality.
