Kevin Laine Brouwer, 64, passed away on February 6, 2017 at the Sulphur Veterans Center in Sulphur, Oklahoma following a lengthy illness. A committal service will be held at Lone Prairie Cemetery, Kansas, OK.

Kevin was born January 24, 1953 in Grinnell, Iowa, the second child of Gary and Nadine (Johnson) Brouwer. As a youth, he attended school in Malcom and Montezuma, IA. He was a 1971 graduate of Montezuma Community High School and served on active duty in the U.S. Army from 1971 to 1975. While stationed in Ft. Huachuca, Arizona, Kevin developed a life-
