Audrey E. Halverson, 93, of Marshalltown, IA passed away Sunday, June 18, 2017, at

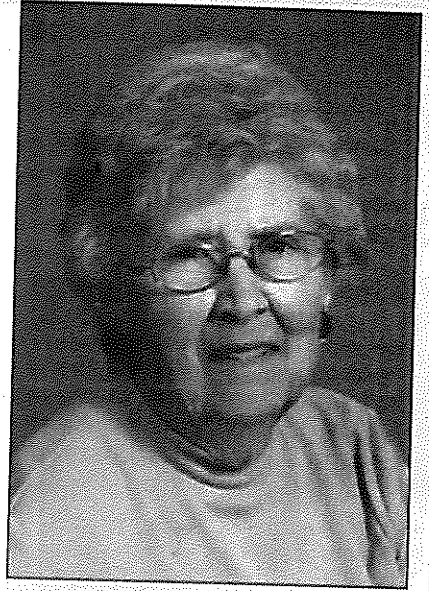
