Beverly Marie Schrader, 71, of Greeley, CO died May 28, after a year-long battle with cancer.

In 1999, after Richard retired, they moved to Greeley, CO and Beverly continued working part-time at the North Colorado Therapy Center.

She was a very active member of Trinity Lutheran Church, especially with the LWML group. She really enjoyed her membership with both the Red Hat Society and the Investment Club in Greeley. Beverly volunteered for nearly ten years at the gift shop at Medical Center of the Rockies in Loveland.

The couple enjoyed multiple trips to the Caribbean with close friends and also enjoyed attending the Rockies and Broncos games in Denver. Together with her daughter, Beverly loved hiking the Colorado "14ners" and completed six by the time she was 62 years old.

Beverly is survived by her husband, Richard of Greeley; daughter, Jody Legg (Emery Legg) of Golden; son, Clint Schrader (Monica) of Camarillo, California; grandson, William Schrader; granddaughter, Reagan Schrader; and sister, Lois Winegarden of Deep River, Iowa.
