GILMAN WOMAN STRICKEN.

Mrs. Fred Graves Dies Monday Foreneon from Pneumonia Following Relapse From Flui

Mrs. Fred Graves, wife of a young farmer living near Gilman, died about !! 11 a. m. Monday forenoon, a victim of pneumonia. Mrs. Graves had the influenza and thought she had recovered, and went to the funeral of a neighbor. She took cold and a relapse followed which terminated fatally.
