ACCIDENT KILLS F. WARING.

Former Resident of Washington Township
Killed at His Home in
Albion, Iowa.

Frank Waring, a former resident of Washington township who lived about six miles southwest of Grinnell, was accidentally killed Monday morning at his home in Albion, Iowa. He was walking on the street when he was struck by a boy riding a bicycle with such force that he was knocked over, and died from the effects of the fall.

The body was brought to this place, arriving Thursday morning. Funeral was held from the Westfield church the same day at 11 a. m. The body was accompanied here by a brother of deceased, B. B. Waring, of Portland, Oregon, who happened to be in the state. Mrs. T. H. Cowell, of Chicago, a sister, arrived Thursday morning to attend the funeral.

Mr. Waring was the father of Mrs. Ernest Lincoln, of Washington township.
